Dr. Toby Lepley

Dr. Toby Lepley is the Associate Vice-President and State 4-H Program for the LSU AgCenter in Baton Rouge, Louisiana. In Dr. Lepley's role he provides leadership to the Louisiana 4-H Youth Development Program which reaches over 175,000 youth annually through school and community based 4-H clubs as well as curriculum enrichment programs. In addition to the 4-H Youth Development Program, Dr. Lepley oversees the LSU AgCenter livestock show program, the Louisiana 4-H Foundation, and Camp Grant Walker Educational Center located in Pollock, Louisiana. Beyond the 4-H Youth program, Dr. Lepley shares leadership responsibilities with two other program leaders in directing operations of the Louisiana Extension Service. Prior to joining the LSU AgCenter administrative team in 2018, Dr. Lepley worked twenty-five years for the Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service in the roles of Assistant State 4-H Leader, 4-H Specialist at the district and state levels, and a County Extension Agent in Austin and Victoria Counties.
