VSCP High School Spotlight: Fisher High School

In the Fall of 2019, Fisher High School made an exciting new addition to their agriculture program! Partnering with Texas A & M Extension, they are now offering a veterinary assistant course. The 9th-12th grade students are given the opportunity to learn through classroom instruction their first year in the program followed by their 2nd year gaining experience hands-on in the local veterinary clinics. The program's first year consists of 8 students who are given a mixture of hands-on practice with our classroom's stuffed animals, virtual tours, guest speakers, and top of the line curriculum. Fisher School's career and agricultural program focuses on providing training and certifications that will better assist our students in transitioning into the workforce after their high school education. Fisher School currently offers Certified Nursing Assistant, small engines class,



food science, greenhouse management and commercial drivers license permit test preparation along with the veterinary assistant course. We are working towards offering OSHA 10 training and Healthsaver CPR/Basic Life Support in the future. We are excited to see our grant-funded classroom greenhouse take shape, summer of 2021. We are elated to watch this program grow and evolve in the years to come and are thankful to the amazing individuals at Texas A&M extension for partnering with us!
